

## Housing needs survey for Barcheston & Willington parish

Do you want to downsize, are you currently living at home with parents and want your own home, do you need a bungalow in preference to a house?

A lack of suitable housing is an issue for many rural parishes and can sometimes lead to local people moving away.

## This form is to be completed ONLY if you have a need for alternative housing and wish to live within the parish.

If you know anyone currently living elsewhere who would like to return to live in Barcheston & Willington parish please ask them to complete a separate form. They would need to have a strong local connection, eg they work in the parish, previously lived in the parish or have a close relative currently living in the parish.

This data is collected, with the approval of Barcheston & Willington Parish Meeting, for the purpose of identifying parish-wide housing need only and will not be used for any other purpose. Individual returns will be anonymised and analysis will be carried out by WRCC (an independent local charity). All information will be treated in strict confidence and no third party will see individual replies.

A separate form should be completed by each household in need of alternative housing and if they wish to be housed within the parish within the next five years. If necessary, please request extra forms; see contact details on the back page.
