Housing needs survey for Long Compton parish

Do you want to downsize, are you currently living at home with parents and want your own home? Do you need a bungalow in preference to a house? Do you work in the parish and would also like to live locally?

The shortage of suitable and affordable housing has long been a challenge for rural communities, with property prices consistently rising far beyond average incomes. Since the last housing needs survey was carried out in 2019, Long Compton Parish Council is now seeking to update its understanding of current local housing needs.

The form is to be completed ONLY if you have a need for alternative housing and wish to live within the parish.

If you know someone who currently lives outside the parish but would like to move to Long Compton they are welcome to complete their own survey form. To be eligible they must have a local connection, for example, they may work in the parish, have previously lived here, or have close family members who currently reside in the parish.

Data is being collected on behalf of Long Compton Parish Council by WRCC, an independent charity supporting rural communities across Warwickshire, to assess housing needs across the parish. All responses are treated confidentially, and individual returns are anonymised.

If your household (whether you're a family, couple, or single person) needs alternative housing within the parish in the next five years, please complete a survey form. Additional forms are available upon request - see the contact details on the back page.
